Sean McCutcheon and Jim Trussler, [Letters, Jan.8], are making a series of falsehoods and factual distortions. Contradicting Judy Haiven, McCutcheon states: "the "activists" on board that ship [Mavi Marmara] were not unarmed... and attacked the Israeli commandos with bludgeoning weapons." Former US Marine, Kenneth O'Keefe, who was on the boat, stated: "A Turkish photographer was shot and killed [by Israeli commandos on the helicopters] before the first soldier landed on the boat." [Haaretz. Sept. 24, 2010]. He also stated that the peace activists ,when attacked on the boat, in international waters, used clubs and rods and threw chairs at the soldiers attacking them [Haaretz. Oct.1, 2010]. The UN Human Rights Council Report [Sept. 28, 2010] stated: "Israel committed grave violations of human rights and international humanitarian law" and "The Council found the blockade unlawful."

Jim Trussler claims that Israel is a true democracy and "where citizens-Jew, Christian and Arab alike- and foreigners are free to criticize the state." Contrary to this, there are scores of Israeli laws that deny its Christian and Muslim citizens basic rights. A Haaretz editorial [Dec. 2, 2010.] is titled: "Israel can't be a democracy with two classes of citizens". An article, by Gideon Levy [Haaretz. Dec. 12, 2010] is titled: "The farce of a secular and democratic state", confirms that. He goes on to state: "It is time to admit that this approach can only be called racist." The recent declarations, by hundreds of Israeli rabbis calling on Jews not to rent their apartments to Arabs, is a manifestation of the racism there.
